The Nuts weekend

A famous word in Bastogne. Three days after the Germans began their advance on Bastogne, US General Anthony McAuliffe established an emergency HQ at the **Bastogne Barracks**.

The Germans, encircling the town, sent a message demanding surrender. McAuliffe's response was short but clear: "Nuts!". The commemorations decided to pay homage to this great military man...

- A book and historical document fair
- Historical re-enactments
- WW2 veterans
