The farm is keen on respecting the environment: waste sorting, composting, a good insulation for all lodgings, a wood stove and solar panels witness this effort.

Breakfast is generous, offering a wide range of products. You can also book a *table d'hôte* to try the terroir products of the Herve region.

All guests have access to a **large terrace**, overlooking the valley: quite a fantastic view... Children can play in the vast garden where swings, sandpit, badminton set and pétanque ground await.

Walking trails and a RAVel (line 38) start near the farm.

Amongst the many touristic attractions near the farm are: Aubel, the Blegny mine, the Val-Dieu abbey, some of the prettiest villages in Wallonia...
