The museum found its home in the former convent of the Sépulcrines, built in the Mosan Renaissance style then rebuilt after the first World War.

Permanent collections

There 4 different spaces to visit:

- Archaeological gallery: 20th century fossils and artefacts
- Architecture gallery: all about churches, houses, castles
- Cultural heritage gallery,: fine art, folklore from the Middle Ages to now

- Weapons gallery

- Guided tours from 10 to 30 persons
- Duration: 30 to 90 minutes
- Booking is mandatory

The museum regularly organises animations for schools and the public along the year, as well as themed exhibitions.
