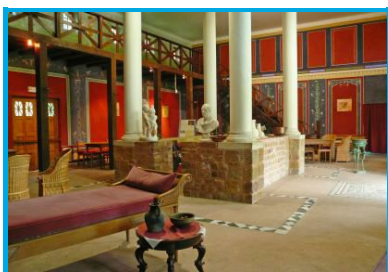




Travel 5,000 years in time at the Archéosite and the Musée d'Aubechies
