Each summer, this giant maize labyrinth chooses a different theme. In 2023, it will be Skinny, a cute diplodocus looking for its egg and going on adventures.

This maze is a completely natural theme park. Come and wander through its 6 km of paths and 11 ha of corn, organised as 6 different worlds:

- A giant corn maze with entertainment and shows.
- A maze of arrows where you have to answer riddles (take a pencil along)

• A restaurant area decorated as a "Jurassic" atmosphere
